I picked this up from a 2nd hand record store in my hometown for \$100CDN. I hadn't realised that the LP revival was in full swing so I bought it out of curiosity together with a few used albums. I had let all mine go (like a fool and a song) when I emigrated 11 years ago. Anyway, I felt it was a reasonable price compared to other more advanced items in the store. I should have looked closer, it doesn't have a cueing lever and on the head there is a very insubstantial finger hold (don't know the correct word) which is difficult to accurately use especially with sausage fingers. Other than those drawbacks I was OK with the operation of the machine generally. There are no counter weights or anti skate devices but until I can afford a better machine I am quite satisfied with it. I am no Audiophile but the sound I was hearing was rich. Definitely a starter model.
